



CRITERIUM RACE TRACK:

This 1.3km race track is predominantly used for cycling during the summer months and also makes up a significant part of the Clipsal 500 Circuit. It can be broken in to two loops the pit straight and the front straight which are both approximately 1.2km in length.

Who can use it?

The race track is open to the whole community except when booked exclusively for an event. Regular users of the track include Cycling SA, Skinny Lattes Cycling Club, International Pedal Prix, VLCC and SA Masters Cycling Association.

How much does it cost to book for an event?

You can hire the track for \$44 (minimum of 4 hours \$11 per hour thereafter) on weekdays or \$65 (minimum of 4 hours \$16.50 per hour thereafter). To enquire about booking the track call Adelaide City Council on 8203 7203.

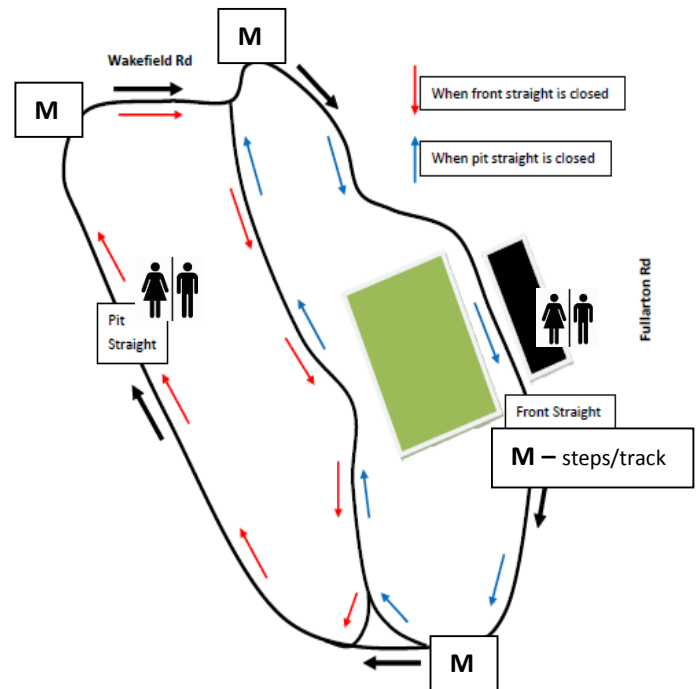
Are there directions for use?

The following instructions apply when using the track:

- Always use the track in a clockwise direction.
- Only Authorised vehicles are permitted in Victoria Park – please close park entry gate behind you.
- Organisers of a closed cycling event may change this procedure at their discretion
- If a cycling event is in progress hi-vis marshals will advise/direct (see areas marked "M" on map above).
- Cyclists are required to wear an approved bicycle helmet.
- Lights must be used before sunrise or after sunset.
- Keep to the left if travelling slowly; avoid sudden braking or changing direction.
- Unauthorised motor vehicles and remote control equipment are not permitted on the track.

Who has right of way on the track?

Cyclists have right of way when using the track. Dogs are not permitted off-leash when the track is in use by one or more cyclist. **People using this facility do so at their own risk.**



PREMIUM SPORTS FIELD & HERITAGE GRANDSTAND:

The premium Sports Field is located adjacent to the Heritage Grandstand in Victoria Park and is bordered by the Criterium Track. The field is approximately 120m x 85m has flood lighting and sleeves in place for Rugby League goal posts. The Heritage Grandstand features two change rooms with toilets and showers. It is accessible and also has a disabled toilet additional female toilets, First Aid and cloakroom and a presentation room.

Who can use it?

The premium sports field is open to the whole community except when in use by license holders or booked exclusively by an event. Gridiron SA hold some of their league matches on the field in summer and it is often used for school holiday activities. Organisations booking the premium field have the option of booking the indoor facilities within the Heritage Grandstand.



VICTORIA PARK FACILITIES

How much does it cost to book for an event/match?

You can hire the premium sports field for \$40 per hour, lights are an additional \$50 per hour. Annual and seasonal licences ranging from \$3,167 are available to Clubs, Associations and Educational Institutions. To enquire about booking these facilities call Adelaide City Council on 8203 7203.

Are goals, line marking and changing facilities included in the hire fee?

No there are additional fees ranging from \$20 per hour* to hire the facilities within the Heritage Grandstand. Organisers are responsible for providing their own goals and line marking. Public toilets are located at the back of the Heritage Grandstand and within the pit straight circuit of the Criterium Track. For more information contact Adelaide City Council on 8203 7203.

*Deposit, bond and cleaning fees also required.

SOUTHERN SPORTS FIELDS:

The Southern Sports Fields are located south of the Central Gardens within the Park and are made up of 3 cricket ovals with hard wickets in summer and 7 sports pitches and a football oval in winter. The sports predominantly played on the sports fields in winter are Rugby Union and Soccer.

Who can use them?

The Southern Sports Fields are open to the whole community except when in use by license holders or booked exclusively by an event. Winter Licence holders are Prince Alfred College (one sports Field and Football Oval) and Christian Brothers College (two sports fields). In summer the South Australian Cricket Association (3 Ovals) and Christian Brother College (1 Oval) hold a licence.

How much does it cost to book a field for an event/match?

You can hire a field for \$30 per hour or for full day hire it is \$160. You can hire all of the southern fields for a fee of \$500. Annual and seasonal licences ranging from \$3,167 are available to Clubs, Associations and Educational Institutions. To enquire about booking these facilities call Adelaide City Council on 8203 7203.

Are goals, line marking and changing facilities included in the hire fee?

No there are no facilities located near to the Southern Fields; the closest facilities are located in the Heritage Grandstand. Public toilets are located at the back of the Heritage Grandstand and within the pit straight circuit of the Criterium Track. Organisers are responsible for providing their own goals and line marking. Sleeves are in place on the football oval as well as for rugby/soccer goals on the sports fields. FITNESS LOOP & SWEAT TRACK:

A 1.9km fitness loop situated in the park with 5 outdoor exercise stations placed along it. This loop is popular with runners, walkers and dog walkers. The Sweat Track is located on the Park Lands Trail (ochre bitumen path) adjacent to East Terrace and includes several activity stations including hurdles, sit ups and lunges.

PETANQUE PISTE:

The Petanque Piste is located adjacent to East Terrace a short walk from the Western entrance to the central gardens. The petanque piste has a BBQ facility adjacent to it and can be used by the whole community.

PARKING:

Off Street Parking is available at the following locations:

- Fullarton Road to the North East of the Park.
- Beaumont Road via South Terrace in the South West of the Park.
- East Terrace on the West side of the Park.
- Wakefield Road on the North side of the park.
